INFORMATION ON THE CCC MARKING OF LOW-VOLTAGE SWITCHGEAR (23 JULY 2013):

The CCC (China Compulsory Certification) mark is a Chinese certification required for certain products. Products listed in the "Catalogue of CCC Certification" are subject to certification and must be provided with the CCC mark so that these products may be placed on the market in China.

Articles requiring certification include the following: inductive, capacitive and optical proximity switches, position switches, limit switches, interlocking safety devices, command and signalling devices etc. with a voltage range greater than 36 V.

Articles with a voltage range less than or equal to 36 V are explicitly excluded and are not subject to certification and therefore do not require CCC marking.

In particular for shipments of spare parts to China, we recommend that these parts be clearly declared and that the operating voltage range be specified on the delivery papers included with the shipment because the Chinese authorities/customs authorities cannot always assign a product with absolute certainty.
